Draper Tools' commitment to reducing plastic packaging

We're changing our approach to plastic packaging to use less, greener or no plastic. This has involved re-thinking how we choose, design and package our product range.



Since 2019 we've been:



Switching plastic for cardboard



Removing unnecessary plastic



Changing how products are packed



Reducing use of polystyrene

Using more recycled/sustainable materials



For example, Switched from plastic blister packaging to card hanging boxes.

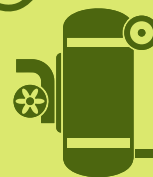
Hex keys will now generate **1.5 tonnes LESS plastic** every year.



Tyre pressure gauges **0.9 tonnes**



Air tools will now generate **0.25 tonnes LESS plastic** waste every year.



Changing to greener alternatives



Removed plastic bags and cellophane film



Cardboard boxes are shredded and reused as cushioning inserts

Switching to **part-recycled plastic** when it's not feasible to remove plastic entirely.



Our progress so far...

We've cut the annual tonnage of plastic packaging by **over 20%**



That's nearly **18 tonnes** of plastic waste removed from what we expect to sell in **2023**

More than 1 tonne

of the plastic packaging we expect to sell in **2023** will be made from at least **30% recycled materials**



Air cushion film is made from

80% recycled plastic



We monitor all of our business operations with the aim of doing things more efficiently than the year before, whether that's by making reductions in unnecessary packaging, waste and greenhouse gas emissions, or by reviewing our supply chain management and our warehouse logistics – stay tuned for our next update on carbon.
